ARTIST'S RENDERING WILL CELEBRATE TULLAHOMA *Pen and ink drawing sponsored by area businesses will benefit local non-profit organizations*

March 1, 2017 --ALLIANCE, OH-- CityScapes Artwork, in association with 2 Live Productions, is currently preparing to create a unique pen and ink drawing which will capture some of the history and notable landmarks in the community of Tullahoma, Tennessee.

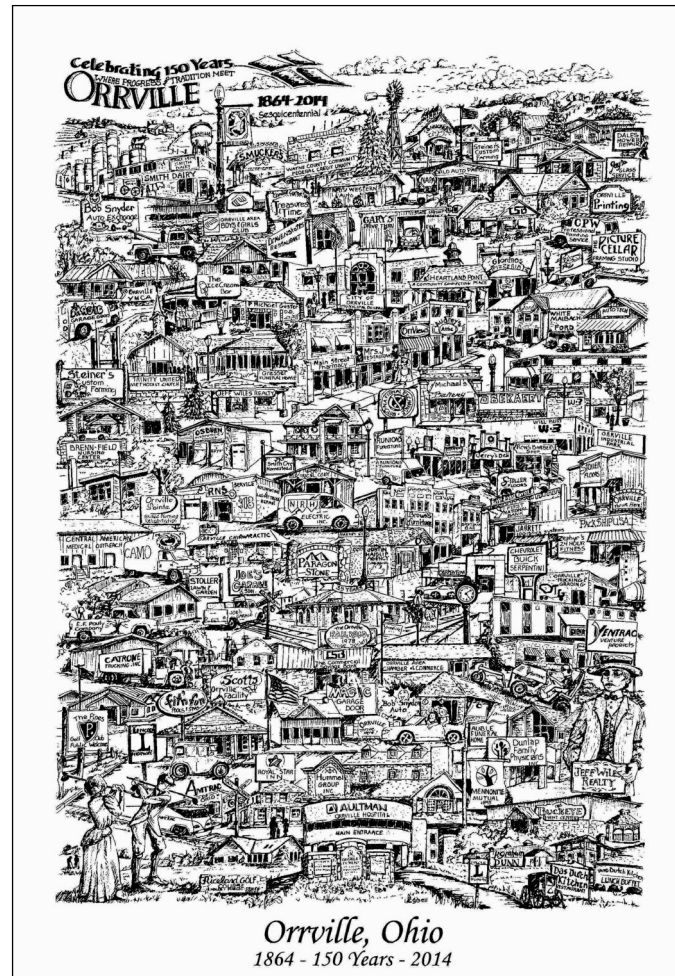
CityScapes Artwork representatives will be contacting area businesses and groups in preparation for this project. The goal of these contacts is not to obtain local endorsements, but rather to obtain feedback on the project, including photos and information on what to include in the artistic rendering. Some of these businesses will have the opportunity to be a part of the drawing as well. Once all the needed information and photographic references are gathered, this fully unique drawing will be created by a commissioned artist to be printed in limited numbers for donation to community organizations who will sell them to raise funds for their causes, keeping 100% of the proceeds.

“These cityscape projects are something we look to do just once every 20 years or so in selected communities,” said Robert Magee, project manager for CityScapes Artwork. “Tullahoma has a fascinating history and a wealth of notable people and landmarks to draw inspiration from. I have no doubt our commissioned artist will find it a very rewarding and delightful project to work on as she produces a beautiful rendering to celebrate the community.”

The Tullahoma historical print will join other cities which have been preserved in this format, including locations such as Orrville, Ohio (pictured to the right), Titusville, Florida, and Washington, Pennsylvania, as well as many more.

Included among the organizations receiving prints for their fundraising efforts in connection with this project so far are the Highland Rim Kiwanis Club, Tullahoma Sunrise Rotary Club, Tullahoma Art Center, and South Jackson Civic Center. CityScapes Artwork anticipates more organizations being added to the list of those receiving donations in the coming weeks.
